

OYO Geospace's Safety Record Surpasses One Million Zero Lost-Time Employee Hours

Houston, TX. (August 5, 2009) – On July 23, 2009, OYO Geospace's Houston facility again surpassed the million employee-hours without a single lost-time safety incident.

"This record safety achievement is a tribute to OYO Geospace's employees," said Gary Owens, President and CEO of OYO Geospace. "Each of our employees has made a personal commitment to safety and they are working together to eliminate incidents and injuries.."

This achievement equals the 2008 safety record of one million employee-hours worked without a lost-time incident, which ultimately exceeded the two million hour mark.

In 2007, OYO Geospace Houston adopted the Houston MSS (Management Safety System), a safety process that targets at-risk behaviors and includes peer-to-peer observations and problem-solving leadership.



"There is really no issue more important than the safety of our employees. Through our MSS initiative, employees drive in our safety process," says HSE Director David Doyle.
